

## Band Camp Information & Checklist

This year's band camp will be held at Schreiner University in Kerrville from August 1-5. The following is a checklist of things you will need to bring to Band Camp:

Instrument (and mouthpiece, reeds, valve oil and slide grease as it pertains to your instrument)	
Music Lyre	
Flip Folder with at least 10 pages	
3-ring Binder with at least 10 clear plastic pages

Alarm Clock	
Twin Sheets, blanket/sleeping bag, pillow	
Lanyard to keep your key. Lost keys cost \$75 to replace.	
Hygiene items (bring what you need)	
Towels and washcloths

\* Bring clothes that are comfortable to march in. We are going to camp to work, so looking great is not the most important thing to consider. Everyone should bring at least one pair of comfortable shoes to march in. Tennis shoes are fine. Flip flops, sandals and boots will not be allowed to be worn during any marching rehearsals. Caps and sunglasses are fine. Please remember that we are on a school sponsored event so the dress code will be followed. Mr. Lancaster will make all decisions if a question arises about any clothing that is considered inappropriate.
