

Registration Worksheet (Winds & Percussion)

You will need to write two separate checks on registration night – one to Dripping Springs Bands and one to Dripping Springs Band Boosters.

Check payable to Dripping Springs Bands:

Item	This fee is for:	Cost of item	Your Cost (write in)
Charter Bus and District Driver Fee	Charter buses for contests on October 1 st and November 5 th . For these contests, we will leave early in the morning and return late. Students will be able to sleep and eat on these buses much more easily than on school buses. \$25 of this fee will pay ½ of the transportation costs required by the district when the band uses district drivers on school buses. This fee is required for everyone.	\$95	
UIL Solo Entry Fee	Students are required to participate in the UIL Solo Contest in the Spring. This fee will cover the student's entry and pay for a medal if they receive a 1 st division on their solo. This fee is non-refundable.	\$8	
Band Show T-Shirt	Show shirt with the contest show theme on it. These shirts are worn during the season at pep rallies and marching contests. Required for all students.	\$15	
Cleaning Fee	Each band uniform will be dry cleaned a minimum of 4 times during the year. The cost for one cleaning of the uniform is \$12. If the uniforms must be cleaned more than 4 times, an additional payment may be needed at the end of the year. Required for all students except Color Guard.	\$48	
Instrument Rental	<p>Required for students who play percussion, tuba, baritone, French horn, bari sax, bass clarinet, contra bass clarinet, and bassoon, as well as for students who use a school-owned trombone. School instruments will be checked out during registration.</p> <p>The fee goes towards (but does not entirely cover) cleaning of the instruments at the end of the year, minor dent removal, and replacing pads on woodwind instruments. The percussion fee will include replacing heads that break throughout the season, and repairs on harnesses.</p> <p>The band program will charge students for any repairs that we feel are caused by neglect, or for any damage that requires more than minor repairs.</p>	\$60	
Gloves	Everyone in the band except percussion and Color Guard will wear gloves. These are the same gloves as last year.	\$4/pair	
Band Shoes	Every band member must have 2 pairs of band shoes (1 white pair and 1 black pair). These are the same shoes as last year, and can only be ordered through the school. The salesman will be at a rehearsal in August to size students for the shoes. Anyone needing shoes will pay for them at registration	\$44 for two pairs

Item	This fee is for:	Cost of item	Your Cost (write in)
Band Camp Fee	Housing and meals at band camp. (If a family has more than one sibling in the band the cost is \$160 per person.)	\$185	
Stamp & Sustenance Fee	Bottled water at contests, sodas at football games, and up to 4 contest meals.	\$35	
Water Jug	Uniform water jug provided through the Band Boosters. It is required at band camp, all rehearsals, and all football games. No other water jugs will be allowed, and students will not be allowed to share water jugs (for health reasons). This is the same water jug used last year, so only freshmen, new students, and students whose water jugs are lost or damaged need to buy this.	\$8	
Away game meal fee - 5 meals (Voluntary)	1 meal delivered before each away football game. (Students will not be allowed to leave campus after school, so if they do not purchase this plan they will have to bring a meal from home.) The meal form (for students to choose their meal option) is included with this information packet.	\$37.50	
Band Booster Membership (Voluntary)	The purpose of Dripping Springs Band Boosters is to support all the activities of and promote interest in all DSISD Band programs. Money from booster membership dues provides a small but valuable portion of the money raised by the boosters in support of the band program.	\$25 per family

Item	This fee is for:	Cost of item	Your Cost (write in)
Band Polo	The band polo is the shirt for the informal uniform, which is worn for the first two football games, as well as informal events such as parades. These are the same shirts as last year, so only freshmen or students who have lost or outgrown their shirts need to purchase one. Sizes for polo shirts will be taken at band registration night (samples available to try on), but will be picked up and paid for by students or parents from Laser Graphics (120 Frog Pond Ln. @ Hwy 290) when the shirts are ready.	\$28	

The informal uniform consists of band polo, khaki pants (no more than 4 pockets), a black belt, black socks, and black band shoes. **Please be sure to have the pants and belt before Meet the Tiger Night on August 19th.**

Extra Curricular Participation Fee: In addition to these fees, there will be a \$125 DSISD Extra-Curricular Participation Fee collected by the district early in the school year. This fee is required for all students who participate in High School Athletics, Band (including Color Guard), Cheerleading, or Hi-Steppers. These fees help pay for items that are provided by the District to the students, such as travel, equipment, uniforms and maintenance costs. If a student registers for one of these activities, he or she is required to pay the extracurricular participation fee.
