Required Items Supplied By Student

INFORMAL UNIFORM ITEMS

Winds and Percussion

The Informal Uniform consists of the Black Shorts, Band Polo or Grey Dri-Fit, Black Band Shoes, Cap, Black Belt and Black "no-show" socks. All students must supply the following items for their informal uniform: Black "no-show" socks and a black belt. These items must be purchased by the student no later than August 18th, the informal uniform with Polo will be worn for the Drill Frenzy performance on August 19th.

Colorguard

With the change in Director, the details of the informal uniform are still being worked out. There will be specific items that the students will pay for and the Director will order to ensure consistency. Students will purchase their own specific Keds-style black shoes, all other items will be purchased through the Director. Every attempt will be made to have these items ready to go by August 18th in order to be worn for the Drill Frenzy performance on August 19th.

FORMAL UNIFORMS

Winds and Percussion

Wind and Percussion Members of the Tiger Band are required to wear the Grey Dri-Fit shirt from the Tiger Band Package, **light or dark grey** Lycra athletic shorts, long **white or black** (over the calf) athletic socks to wear under the formal uniform. Students need to purchase the light or dark grey Lycra athletic shorts, long black athletic socks, and long white athletic socks.

Light or dark grey Lycra shorts may be purchased from most any sporting goods store. Not Black.

These items must be purchased by the student no later than September 14th, the formal uniform will be worn for the September 15th football game.

Students wear the light or dark grey Lycra athletic shorts and Grey Dri-fit shirt under their formal uniform, for both marching season and concert season. The long dark socks are worn with the black bibbers (pants) and black shoes, and long white socks are worn with the white bibbers and white shoes. Students will be told which color of bibbers will be worn for each performance.

Colorguard

Undergarment requirements will be determined by costume needs. Mr. Vereen will specify what items will be required. These items must be supplied by the student prior to September 114th, as the formal uniform will be worn for the Football game on September 15th.

Full Band

Either a section shirt or a plain white t-shirt will also be required for Monday night rehearsals. Sections that have acquired their section shirt and all members have one may wear those. Otherwise the section will wear a plain white t-shirt. You should consider purchasing several pairs of white athletic socks to cover all the practices, games and contests (unless you're just into doing late night laundry).
